Co-CHAIR (one vacancy):

Responsible for providing overall leadership and direction to the Executive Committee. Some responsibilities include:

- * Establishing annual priorities for the node
- * Planning and executing events and evaluating their success
- * Leveraging relationships and forming and maintaining partnerships
- * Administering funding, sponsorships, budgets, etc.
- * Ensuring regular communication between Executive Members and with the EHL National co-Chairs

EVENTS Coordinators (two vacancies):
